**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of The Falls Event Center, LLC filed with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Utah the First Interim Application of Holland & Hart LLP and the Chapter 11 Trustee filed the First Interim Application of Rocky Mountain Advisory (collectively, the “**Applications**”).

**YOUR RIGHTS MAY BE AFFECTED. You should read these papers carefully and discuss them with your attorney, if you have one in this bankruptcy case. If you do not have an attorney, you may wish to consult one.**

Pursuant to the Applications, Holland & Hart LLP is requesting interim compensation in the total amount of \$113,516.50 in fees and \$2,150.05 in costs for services rendered from July 26, 2018 through November 26, 2018. And Rocky Mountain Advisory is requesting interim compensation in the amount of \$213,417.00 in fees and \$527.46 in costs for services rendered from August 27, 2018 through November 26, 2018. If any party has received only this Hearing Notice for the Applications, the party may request a copy of the Applications from the Committee or the Chapter 11 Trustee, and the Committee or Chapter 11 Trustee will furnish the party with the requested copies.

The Court will conduct a hearing on the Applications on **March 19, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.** (the “**Hearing**”). The Hearing will take place at (the “**Court**”):

(2) attend the hearing on the Applications which is set for **March 19, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.** in Courtroom 369, United States Bankruptcy Court, 350 Main Street, Salt Lake City, Utah. Failure to attend the Hearing will be deemed a waiver of your objection.

If you or your attorney do not take these steps, the Bankruptcy Court may decide that you do not oppose the relief sought in the Applications and may enter an order granting that relief. In the absence of a timely filed objection, the undersigned counsel or the Chapter 11 Trustee may and will ask the Court to strike the Hearing and enter an order approving the Applications without hearing.
